“Electrical Imaging; An Evolving Geophysical Technology for Characterization and Monitoring of Complex Contaminated Sites”

Dr. Lee Slater is an extensively published and internationally recognized expert in hydrogeophysics. He has served as the Principal Investigator on multiple projects for various federal agencies, Chair of geophysical and hydrological groups and committees for the American Geophysical Union (AGU), President of the Environmental and Engineering Geophysical Society, and has also served on multiple advisory boards for hydrogeological research in Europe.
