- 4) Parking on The College of New Jersey will be in Lot Nos. 4, 5, and 6 and will require a parking pass, which can be downloaded and printed from the NE-AIPG web-site. Be sure to fill in your license plate number on the parking pass.

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- 5) The course is divided into the following three parts:

8:00AM to 12:00PM – Lecture at TCNJ (registration begins at 7:30)

12:00PM to 1:00PM – Box lunch (provided) and travel to the former Naval Air Warfare Center (NAWC); 1540 Parkway Avenue, Trenton NJ – approximately two miles (4 car minutes) from TCNJ campus)

1:00PM to 5:00PM – Students form 20 person groups and attend, on a rotating basis, a tour of the NAWC site and two 30 to 45 minute long geophysical field demonstrations. Each demonstration will highlight a component of the ongoing geophysical program at the site.

- 6) **IMPORTANT** - The course will be given rain or shine, in hot, mild, or cold weather so please dress appropriately. You must be able to stand at and walk between stations. Seating is not available, unless you wish to bring your own folding or portable chair.
